

Cookie Notice

This website (www.wanderers.ie) uses cookies. A cookie is a file containing an identifier (a string of letters and numbers) that is sent by a web server to a web browser and is stored by the browser. The identifier is then sent back to the server each time the browser requests a page from the server.

Cookies may be either "persistent" cookies or "session" cookies: a persistent cookie will be stored by a web browser and will remain valid until its set expiry date, unless deleted by the user before the expiry date; a session cookie, on the other hand, will expire at the end of the user session, when the web browser is closed. A first-party cookie is set by the website being visited. A third-party cookie is set by a different website.

Cookies are typically categorised as "strictly necessary", "functional", "performance" and "behavioural targeting".

Strictly necessary cookies help make a website usable by enabling basic functions like page navigation and access to secure areas of a website. A website cannot function properly without these cookies. Strictly necessary cookies do not collect personally identifiable information (personal data) and do not require user consent under applicable data protection/privacy laws (EU General Data Protection Regulation 2016/679 and EU ePrivacy Directive 2002/58/EC (as implemented under Irish law). However, websites must be transparent about the use of strictly necessary cookies and inform users about how these cookies are used. Other cookie categories require appropriate consent.

ASPSESSIONIDCGBDSTTS	First-party	Session	This cookie name is generally associated with use as a general-purpose platform session cookie, used by sites written with Microsoft ASP based technologies. The structure of the cookie name is a common root - ASPSESSIONID, followed by a series of unique letters. It is usually used to maintain an anonymised user session by the server.	Strictly necessary
